DEALER CONTRACT

28th ANNUAL SHOW & SALE
PHYSICAL EDUCATION CENTER
THE ESSEX CAMPUS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF BALTIMORE COUNTY
SUNDAY MARCH 2, 2008

The rental fee is **\$45.00** per table with a limit of 3 tables per dealer. All tables are 2' by 8.' Chairs will be provided. Reservations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis, with a priority given to those dealers who attended our 2007 show. **To insure reservations, you must pay all fees in advance.** Our space is limited to 305 tables, and we have had sellouts for the past 20-plus years. We will attempt to honor locations from the previous years, unless otherwise requested. Each dealer who rented a table at last year's show and whose Reservation Form is received by **December 15, 2007**, is guaranteed a table space.

Because we are in a gymnasium, please be careful with food and drink. The floor is very sensitive to food spills and particularly cola spills. By signing this Contract, the dealer/exhibitor assumes liability for any damage he/she inflicts on the floor. **Smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages are prohibited inside the Physical Education Center.**

Dealers will be allowed to bring their boxed sale items in at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday March 1. **Boxes must remain closed, and nothing will be allowed on top of the tables until 6:00 p.m.** The building will be locked and secured at 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 1.

Set-up time for the Show on Sunday, March 2 is from 6:00-7:30 a.m. **Those not set up by 7:30 a.m. will forfeit their tables and all fees.** Please note that opening time of the show is 8:00 a.m., and closing time is 3:00 p.m. **DEALERS MUST REMAIN SET UP FOR THE FULL TERM OF THE SHOW.** If you start packing and/or leave before the end of the show, you will not be offered a Contract for the coming year.

Sub-leasing of tables is prohibited.

Only one (1) assistant is allowed per dealer regardless of the number of tables contracted. Only the listed dealer and assistant will be allowed into the building at set-up time. Issued name badges must be worn prominently.

Even though we do allow tabletop antiques, we expect the dealer to bring at least **40% of their wares as bottles.**

The dealer agrees to be solely responsible for his/her contract, agents, employees and assistants and releases the Baltimore Antique Bottle Club, Inc., its directors, officers and members from all claims for theft or damage to person or property from any cause whatsoever during the occupancy of said dealer on the premises.

- Confirmation and table assignments will be sent to dealers approximately 7-8 weeks before the show.
- If you cannot make the show, please let the Show Chairman know as soon as possible. In order to receive a refund, a cancellation request must be received at least two weeks before the show (on or before Feb.18, 2008). No-shows (i.e. absence without prior notification) may not be offered future contracts.
- Only bottles, jugs, glassware, advertising, breweriana, and similar items along with tabletop antiques - **not collectibles** - are to be sold. We must insist that glass and related items remain the emphasis of the show.
- Reproductions and repaired items must be clearly marked as such on the item. No artificially colored glass may be offered for sale at this show. Sale price is to be clearly marked on all items.
- There will be no early buyers at the show.
- For safety and insurance purposes, large objects such as hand-trucks, boxes, stands, personal tables, etc. are not permitted in the aisles or between tables during the show. Maintain vigilance regarding your belongings.
- ABSOLUTELY NO parking on the grass; the college officials will have you towed. Also, unloading and parking are prohibited just outside the side entrances. **These spaces are off –limits to vehicles.**
- Dealers must provide their own table coverings, and all tables are to be covered.
- We request that table cards identifying you as the dealer be visible throughout the show.

SALES TAX: Maryland law requires that all dealers collect 5% Maryland Sales Tax. The Club is required to provide all dealers' names and addresses to the State Compliance (Sales Tax) Division prior to the Show date. Dealers may be mailed a temporary 30-day license by the Compliance Division before or after the Show at no cost to them. **If you have received the license you must bring it with you at the Show.** Collecting and reporting Sales Tax is the responsibility of the individual dealer, not the responsibility of the Baltimore Antique Bottle Club, Inc.

PLEASE NOTE: Should the Baltimore Antique Bottle Club, Inc. be unable to hold the show at the location and date mentioned due to inclement weather or other circumstances beyond its control, the dealer waives the right to any claim for damage or other compensation.

Any breach of this contract will result in the dealer not being offered a contract for the coming year.

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
